1. A current official transcript of your high school record. This transcript should indicate your grade average through the last semester completed prior to applying for this scholarship.
2. Submit an official copy of your ACT or SAT test scores.
3. In one page submit a typewritten narrative indicating your present college plans and your future career plans. This statement should include some of the following but is not limited to these questions. What is your planned field of study? Why did you choose this field? What do you plan to do career-wise? What are your goals or future expectations? Sign your name at the top of your essay.
4. Any of the above supplemental information not accompanying the application will result in the disqualification of the applicant from consideration.
5. Assemble all papers with a paper clip. DO NOT STAPLE.
