

BUS CONDUCT REPORTS for SCHOOL BUS DUMAS INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT



1. Bus drivers and /or bus monitors are expected to maintain discipline and order on school buses at all times.
2. Students who violate bus discipline rules shall receive a bus conduct report on the same day as the incident.
3. Bus conduct reports are to be submitted to the Transportation Director who will review the report.
4. Upon completion of the review, the bus conduct report shall be delivered to the school principal who will notify the student and parent of the violation and consequences.

1st Violation: Removal from the bus for 3 days.

2nd Violation: Removal from the bus for 10 days.

3rd Violation: Removal from the bus for remainder of the school year.

Students who are removed from the bus shall be allowed to ride the following school day in order that parents may make other arrangements.

5. Parents may request a meeting if they have any questions about a violation. A meeting will be set up with the parent, the student in question, the bus driver and or bus monitor, the principal of the school, and the director of operations.
